AIRPORTS

Greenwich is served by three major and one regional airport.

Newark Liberty Airport (EWR)

www.panynj.gov

Newark is the most distant, it is approximately 90 minutes from Greenwich. It is an international airport and somewhat less congested than the other two major airports and sometimes has less expensive flights. It is a Continental Airlines hub.

Kennedy Airport (JFK)

Kennedy is the major international area airport. It is approximately 70 minutes from Greenwich.

La Guardia Airport (LGA)

La Guardia is the major domestic area airport. It is 45 minutes from Greenwich.

Westchester County Airport (HPN)

This small, modern airport is located only 10 minutes from Greenwich. Most of the major airlines including US Air, United, American, Delta and Continental fly into Westchester. Most of the major car rental companies also have facilities on the airport.

The New Haven Line offers frequent service to and from Grand Central Station in New York City. Express trains usually bypass Greenwich and stop in Stamford. The time is about 45 minutes. During the week trains run about every hour. Greenwich has four stations: Cos Cob, Greenwich, Old Greenwich and Riverside.

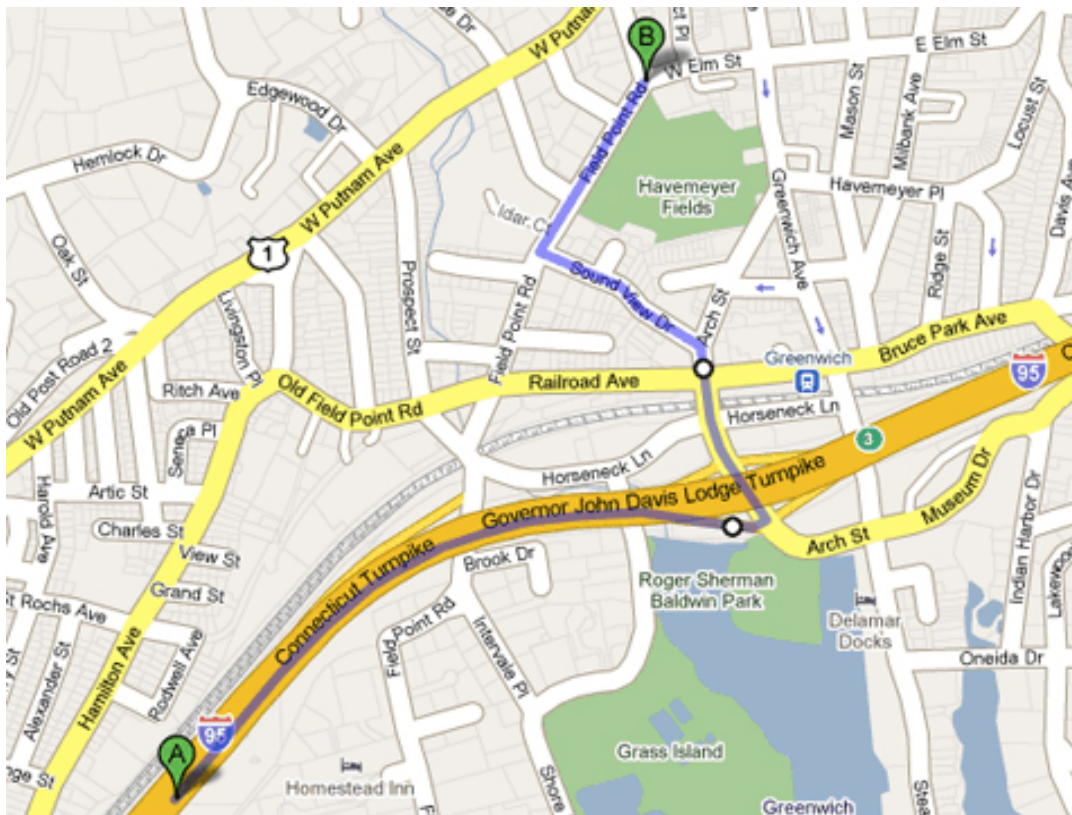
Directions to Mason Street Office from I-95

Southbound

Exit 3: Arch Street. Right at end of ramp. Follow straight through 3 lights, bear right and continue straight up Arch Street. At intersection, follow straight across Greenwich Avenue. At first light, make a Left onto Mason Street. #164 will be on the Left, parking is in the back - Anderson Associates is on the lower level.

Northbound

Exit 3: Arch Street. Left at end of ramp. Follow straight through 3 lights (at this point, follow same directions from Southbound).

Southbound

Exit 31: North Street. Right at end of ramp. Stay straight on North Street for apx. 5-6 miles. At light, continue straight. At small intersection (with no light) turn Left onto North Maple. At light, turn Right onto the Post Road. At third light, turn Left on Mason Street. #164 will be on the Right, parking is in the back - Anderson Associates is on the lower level.

Northbound

Exit 31: North Street. Left at end of ramp. Stay straight on North Street (from this point, follow same directions as Southbound).
